Qualifying Criteria for considering candidates

Strong candidates will have demonstrated excellence in one or more of the following areas:

Excellence in Sports Award

The student should exhibit skill in executing game strategies, commitment and reliability to the team or sport, high level of participation at practices and games supplemented by good grades.

Leadership Award

The successful candidate would demonstrate initiative, inspire others to work creatively and as a team, creates an environment that empowers team members to work effectively without direct supervision, shares knowledge and information relative to the group's success, encourages the development of others through various strategies.

Research and Innovation Award

Celebrates student who creates a solution for greater effectiveness and efficiency.

Environmental Impact Award

Awarded to a student who has significantly contributed to efforts to protect our environment and/or create awareness of practices that harm to halt such practices.

Distinguished Alumni Award

Recognizes a past student for outstanding or notable achievement. (e.g. Creation of an NGO, promotion to senior level management in a large firm or government institution).

Community Service Award

This award honours a student who has been involved in community service. Goes above and beyond the responsibility required by any institution paid or unpaid. They demonstrate commitment - a level of involvement driven by an innate desire for change/improvement in the lives of those they serve.

Award of Merit

Celebrates a student who has excelled academically despite the odds. Has overcome challenging circumstances to achieve their goals.
